Quick Reference Guide to the Discipline Level System

This chart depicts brief examples of offenses at each of the disciplinary levels and the consequences available to administrators.

Level I

- Being tardy to class
 Running or making noise
 Neglecting to bring materials or work to
- 4. Failing to follow classroom/cafeteria Playground rules

Level II

 11.Failing to serve detention
 12.Abusing the use of a hall pass
 13.Possessing lighters, matches, tobacco-less cigarettes, or tobacco-related paraphernalia
 14.Possessing or using a laser pointer
 15.Possessing a current prescription (student's own medication); or possessing or using one's own nonprescription drug

- paintballs, water guns
 17.Possessing a look-alike weapon
 18.Violating the Acceptable Use Guidelines
 19.Telling a falsehood to an adult
 20.Forging or altering school records, parent notes, forms, or other school/home communications
 11.Pofsing or demogrape another's property
- 21.Defacing or damaging another's property 22.Possessing or using a skateboard, scooter, roller blades, shoes with wheels, or other

Level III

- 1. Persistent offenses from Level II,
- including bus infractions
 2. Disrupting the school environment or
- 2. Disrupting the school environment or educational process
 3. Using profane, vulgar, obscene, or threatening language, including hit lists (written or verbal); or obscene gestures
 4. Intentionally or knowingly making libelous or slanderous remarks (verbal or written)
- about others
- Using ethnic, racial or gender-related (verbal or inappropriate acts toward others
- Fighting
- Using lighters or matches

 Possessing or using tobacco
 Possessing, distributing, or using fireworks, stink bombs, smoke bombs, other noxious chemicals, or "shock* pens
 Possessing drug paraphernalia, aerosol paint, or fixative spray
 Possessing, distributing, or creating pornographic or sexually-oriented material or material that promotes violence or other illegal activities
 Possessing, distributing, or concealing a weapon not included as a removable or expellable offense

- 13.Selling, giving, or delivering to another person a non-prescription drug; possessing or using a nonprescription drug other than one's own; or possessing, transmitting, selling, attempting to sell, or exhibiting what is represented to be a prohibited substance
- 14. Attempting to sell/purchase a prohibited substance through verbal or written communication without being in possession
- 15.Stealing or unauthorized possession of another person's property, theft; committing burglary
 16.Exhibiting, delivering, using, or selling look- alike weapons
- 17.Forging or altering school records, parent notes, forms, or other school/home communications (sec.)

 18. Assault of another student or an adult
- that is not a removable or expellable
- 19. Vandalizing, defacing or damaging school property, including non-felony graffiti
- 20.Engaging in behavior that is illegal that does not constitute an expellable offense
- 21.Failing to disclose information, hiding/covering up info/evidence for self or others, committing perjury, or lying as a witness.
- 22. Engaging in inappropriate sexual conduct Mooning; exposing
- 23.Sexual harassment (verbal or written), including stalking
 24.Creating a potential health or safety hazard or a situation that may result in possible injury

 25.Engaging in inappropriate behavior on overnight trips not addressed elsewhere

 26.Gambling

 27.Hacking (illegal or unauthorized entry or attempted entry into computer system)

 28.Interfering with school activities, including trespassing

- 29. Tampering with a fire extinguisher, an automated external defibrillator (AED), or their storage cabinet
- 30.Bullying- more than 3 offenses

Level IV: Removals to DAEP

Mandatory Placements:

- 13.Fraternity, sorority, or secret society activity
- 14.Registered sex offenders under court supervision
